

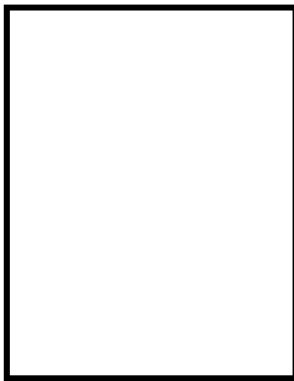


Origami Boat

Model Instructions

Things You'll Need

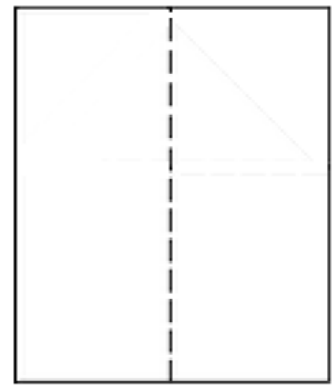
A rectangular sheet of paper, a flat surface on which to work, and a ruler to crease the folds (optional).



1. Begin with a rectangular sheet of paper



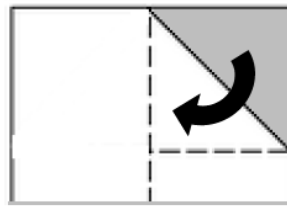
2. Fold the paper lengthwise, then crease the fold



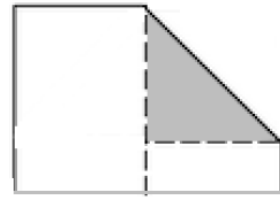
3. Unfold the paper and place it on a flat surface



4. Fold the paper the paper in half widthwise, then crease the fold

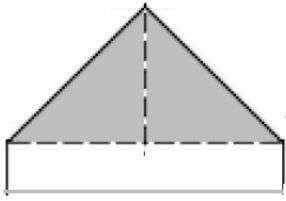


5. Fold the top right corner to the center fold line

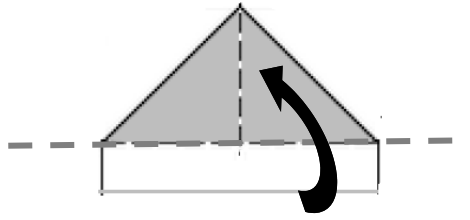


6. Crease the diagonal fold

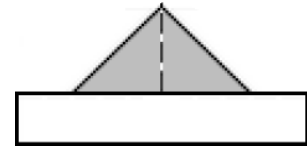
9 More Steps >>



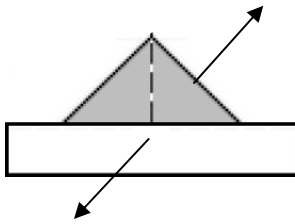
7. When you fold the top left corner to the center fold line, your paper should look like this



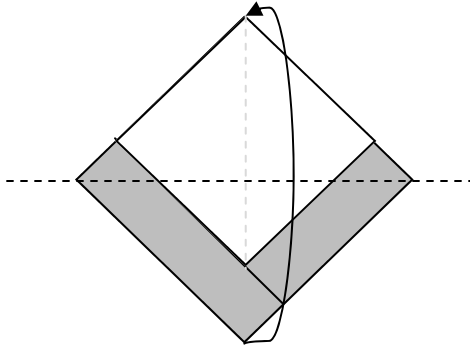
8. Fold the paper below the folded corners up, then crease well. Turn your paper over and do the same thing on the other side.



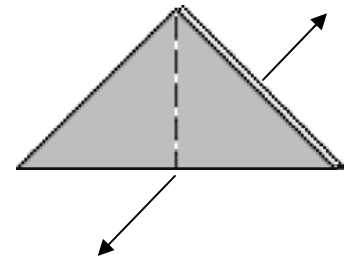
9. After you have folded and creased the bottom on both sides, your paper will look like this.



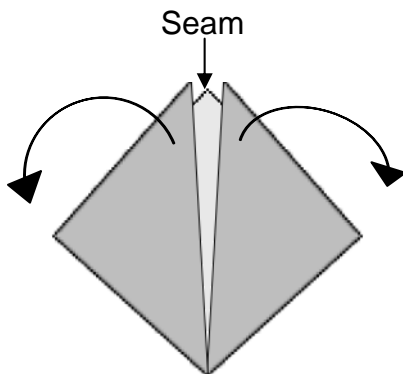
10. Pull the sides out and flatten, then crease



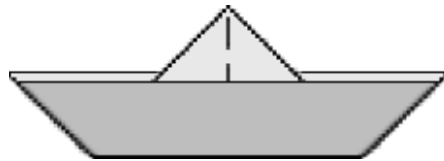
11. Fold the front layer bottom corner to the top, then crease. Turn your boat over and do the same thing on the other side to create a triangle



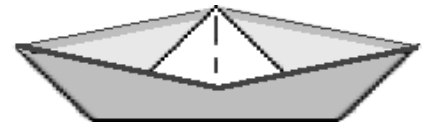
12. Pull the sides of the triangle apart to open up the bottom and make the triangle a square again.



13. Turn the square to make a diamond. Starting at the top of the diamond, gently pull the two triangle sides apart until the seam running down the middle of the diamond opens.



14. Flatten your paper to create all folds



15. Lift your paper, then open it up slightly to form a boat shape.
